Our youth ministry program is for 7th through 12th grade students. Teri leads the 7th and 8th graders, and Mel and Amy lead the high school group, although they combine classes most of the time. The primary focus is to involve the students in the teachings of the Catholic Church. This year, they have focused on social justice issues, which include food insecurities and discrimination.

In the summer, the youth ministry group will participate in a mission trip, volunteering at various locations and spending time learning and praying together.

The youth ministry gathers two or three Sundays each month for an hour and a half. They start with prayer, then share dinner as a group, which is provided by one of the parents. They often do an ice breaker to help the kids interact with each other before beginning a pre-planned discussion. The leaders encourage an open discussion, and every opinion is valued. Sometimes, the youth ministry leaves church for an outside activity such as delivering Christmas cookies and caroling, shopping for the local food pantry, delivering the goods to the pantry, and volunteering to do yard work. Recently, Father Denny joined the youth for a candid conversation. The questions they asked ranged from wanting to know Father's favorite food to how and why he became a priest. They end the evenings with a prayer circle.
